What is the Buddy Werner League (BWL)?

- BWL is a 47 year-old Recreational Ski Race Program for local youth with a focus on growing young skiers physically as well as mentally.
- Participants ski with volunteer coaches and FRIENDS in their age group & ability level for 10-days in Beaver Creek.
- Seven days are all-mountain ski days with some race training and three days will be devoted to racing.
- BWL's goal is to be a FUN, affordable, high-quality ski and race program for all area residents.



Who was Buddy Werner?

Buddy Werner was an internationally renowned alpine ski racer and a member of the Olympic Alpine Team in 1956, 1960 & 1964. Buddy was America's first true world class ski racer. The Buddy Werner League pays tribute to his legend by providing a recreational race program that strengthens young skiers grades 2nd - 8th in their alpine skiing.

*Paperwork is due by 11/15 and is limited to the first 300 skiers. Acceptance to the program is based on a skier's ability, as well as space available in a group with similar ability. New skiers will be tested prior to the start of the season. If it is determined that skier is not of all-mountain ability (level 5), skier will not be accepted in program and entry fee will be refunded.
