Pastor David Reimnitz was raised in Bismarck, ND, where his father served as a Lutheran pastor and district president for more than 20 years. The 6th of 10 children, Pastor Reimnitz experienced the importance of a Christian home—teamwork, athletic discipline, and laughter, values which he continues to demonstrate in his personal and professional interactions with young and old alike.

After completing a Bachelor of Science degree in Natural Sciences, Pastor Reimnitz entered Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, graduating with a Master of Divinity degree in May of 1986. He was called by the Missouri District Board of Missions to be a Missionary-at-Large to the Belton-Raymore area and has served as the pastor of Bethlehem since its beginning in 1987. He celebrated his 31st Wedding Anniversary this past August with his wife Sherry (Kruse) and then the final wedding ceremony of his three children in September.

In addition to his congregation responsibilities, he has served on the Board of Directors for Beautiful Savior Nursing Home, the Lutheran Mission Association of Kansas City, MO, helped establish the Christian Resource Center (a non-profit Concordia Publishing House distribution center), helped start and has served as a Raymore Police Chaplain since May 2011 and was recently elected Circuit Visitor of the Kansas City MO South Circuit.

He has remained active in his continuing education focusing primarily in the area of chaplaincy training as well as completing a 5 year commitment to the Pastoral Leadership Institute. He has taken two mission trips to Mexico to build houses with Casa de Christo, a trip to southern Brazil with PLI and a Medical Mission trip to Madagascar where he served as chaplain for the medical team.

His hobbies include yard work, gardening and working on his day off.
