



BUTTON COORDINATOR

Two or three times a year we make buttons, often in hilary's kitchen.

Job description: Learn to make nifty 2 1/4" buttons using our equipment. Then, initially with our help, organize 2-4 volunteers to make buttons. Supervise 2-hr. sessions 2-3 times per year. Teens, this could be a perfect Community Service opportunity.

Time required: 3 hrs. per session incl. set-up/clean-up. You usually get to choose a time/place that's convenient for you.

Skill set: We'll happily train you on the "machine." We own one and a CanDo friend lends us a second. Training takes about 1/2 hour. In an additional hour, we'll make a batch of buttons so you can learn what to do if something goes amiss.

A bit of arm strength is required to get it done, but buttons may be made sitting or standing, as you like it.
