FAQ for LBC Youth Basketball



Will there will practices other than on Saturdays?

No. We have a short practice time before each game.

When will I find out my child's game schedule?

Teams will be completed by September 18, 2018. **You will receive an email from Liberty Sports** with your team schedule, team color, roster and coach. Please understand we do this to allow as many children to register as possible and you will receive an email when this information is ready.

What does my child need to play basketball?

Your child will need non-marking **tennis shoes** to play basketball. Fancy/name brand shoes are not required or necessary but supportive, athletic shoes are needed.

What about team shirts?

Team t-shirts will be in for week two (September 29, 2018). For week one, if you have a shirt in your team's color, have your child wear it. If not, there is no need to purchase one.

How long is a game?

Game times are from 20—40 minutes long depending on age group.

Is there food available to eat at the church?

The Team Mom will organize parents to bring a snack for the team players each week. There will be a rotating schedule and every parent is asked to bring a team snack on their designated week. (We will do our best to accommodate allergies - if we are unable to accommodate your child's allergy, we will notify you and ask your support in providing a safe snack for your child.)

How will I know if basketball is canceled?

Liberty Bible Church will post it on their website at www.FindLiberty.net and you will receive a phone call from your coach.

Are there activities for my younger children that can't play basketball?

Liberty Bible Church has an indoor playground called the Liberty Zone. It is located on the 3rd floor open to basketball families. Children **MUST** be supervised and wear socks in Liberty Zone.

If my child has not played basketball before, may he or she sign up?

Of course, they can sign up! This is an amazing way for children to learn basketball and team participation.

Is there anything else I should know?

Liberty Sports is a **Christian-youth league** open to players of all skill levels. Our goal is to provide instruction, teach teamwork and promote sportsmanship by providing an encouraging environment in all games, practices and social areas on Basketball Saturdays. We ask for your support and cooperation in this endeavor and ask that you share this with any fans joining you this season.

After each game, the team will travel together to the "**Coaches Corner**" for devotion, Word of the Week and snack. Parents are encouraged to join the team in this space and observe the discussion.
