



Bio Dr. Richard O. Butcher:

Richard Oliver Butcher was born May 16, 1939 in Selma, Alabama to the late Mr. & Mrs. Aljah Langston Butcher, Sr. He is the second eldest of five children. He attended local public schools in Cleveland, Ohio and graduated from Glenville High School in 1956. He received the Bachelor of Science degree from Allegheny College, Meadville, Pennsylvania in 1960. Dr. Butcher decided that he wanted to be a physician when he was a young boy growing up in Cleveland. Two of his best friends had fathers who were physicians who helped shape young Richard's life and gave him the aspiration to seek a career in medicine. It is this strong sense of community and role-modeling that he witnessed as a child that

fueled his spirit and supported his commitment to better the lives of people in the greater San Diego community.

Dr. Butcher received the Doctor of Medicine degree in 1964 from Meharry Medical College, Nashville, Tennessee. Upon completing medical school, Dr. Butcher did a rotating internship at the U.S. Naval Hospital, Great Lakes, Illinois. He was then stationed at MCRD in San Diego and was thereafter assigned to a troop transport ship taking troops to Viet Nam. He completed his residency in general practice at Riverside General Hospital and was certified by the Medical Board of California in 1969.

After his training, Dr. Butcher moved back to San Diego and worked at Ford Medical Center, 1969-1970; Family Medical Group of San Diego, 1970-1973; Western Medical Group, 1973-1986; Family Medical Group of San Diego, 1986-1992; and Care View Medical Group from 1992 until the present.
