'Growing Stronger Together' was both the theme and the outcome of our recent capital campaign effort.

The theme was built upon the premise that the Y has seen significant and unprecedented growth over the past ten years and that upgraded and expanded facilities would allow us to increase our reach and our ability to serve our community. The results of this campaign effort were impressive and humbling.

Together, dozens of volunteers and community leaders from throughout the Fox Cities rallied to raise over \$9.6M to help our dreams become a reality. In total, 754 donors supported the 'Growing Stronger Together' campaign, which will help to provide new facilities, services and programs to our 44,000 members and 69,000 program participants.

The seeds for this campaign effort were first planted at the YMCA Board Summit gathering in November 2012. After 4 years of planning, discussion, design, fundraising and construction we have dedicated all of our new facilities back to our members and our community.
