## Requirements:

1. Applicant choirs shall be 'advanced' ensembles who regularly rehearse and perform Level -4 or higher music.
  2. Each ensemble must prepare and present one Level -4 or higher selection for Mr. Harris under their own director. The title will be submitted in advance.
  3. The ensemble's ringers should be regular members of the ensemble.
  4. Deadline for submitting application and selection is February 1, 2018.
- One-hour sessions with Mr. Harris will be at 10:00 am, 11:15 am and 12:30 pm.
  - A five octave set of Schulmerich handbells and 40' of padded tables will be provided. Ensembles must provide their own handchimes and mallets, if needed.
  - Participating ensembles may choose to use their own equipment, but that may reduce the master class time by 10 minutes in order to set up and break down.
  - Decisions regarding accepted ensembles will be made by committee and ensembles will be notified by February 8, 2018. There is a *\$75.00 charge for the Master Class*, payable upon acceptance.
  - Master Class choirs are strongly urged to participate in the RI Spring Handbell Spectacular. There is a separate registration process and fee for this event.
