



PARK MAITLAND AUDIO & SOUND WORKSHOP (GRADES 4-6)

Workshop is 2 hours in length and promptly begins at 3:30pm and end at 5:30pm.

DESCRIPTION

Express yourself with sound! Learn about beats and Rhythms! Break down a melody from your favorite song! If you're interested in band, playing an instrument, or possibly even being a DJ in the future, then it's time to get your hands on some accessible music apps. Explore rhythm and how it helps define musical genres. Discover ways marketing uses sound to influence the choices you make, and what kind of jobs you can have involving audio. Learn how to measure a song's tempo, write your own song, and kick a beat!

GOAL

Students use hands-on learning and collaboration to practice core skills used in audio and musical arts, creating an original music project of their very own.

OBJECTIVES

Students will be able to:

- Create clips of original music to be used in other projects and full-length songs
- Identify and replicate the beat and melody of a song
- Create a structure, mood, and storyline for a song
- Identify the distinct characteristics of certain genres
- Choose between different instruments and practice identifying individual songs
