

LINE AND WASH WORKSHOP MATERIALS LIST

In this class we will focus on line drawing and watercolor wash. You can just bring the paints and brushes you normally use.

- Watercolor palette
- Paints
- Variety of brushes- including various size rounds and a wash brush.
- Water container
- Paper towel
- Pencil and kneaded eraser
- Permanent fine point markers –you just need a couple of good ones, but you can bring a variety to play with.
 - Sharpie extra fine point is a cheap option (I've used these a lot)
 - Micron
 - Faber Castel
- Marker brush, such as, the Pentel Pocket Brush
- Permanent black India ink
- Any other pen and ink materials you want to experiment with
- Sketchbook or plain paper – 70 lb (or higher)
- 140 lb cold press or hot press watercolor paper
- Watercolor or multi-media sketchbook –or you can just use your watercolor paper. I would like you to start filling up a sketchbook and do at least **25 line drawings in 30 days. IT'S A THROW DOWN!!!**
