FAQ's

1. **Where will you be staying?** One of the reasons I am asking people to sign up early is so that we can secure proper lodging. We will all be staying under one roof in a cabin. Typically I have booked large group cabins that are within a healthy driving distance and a fun place to be. We will follow safe sanctuary procedures with males and females separated at bedtime.
2. **What about free time?** It will be structured. Traditionally there is a large block of time that allows youth groups to hang out together. Whatever we do, from lunch to shopping, to hanging out at the cabin, we all will do together. Students will not be allowed to go "exploring" on their own. Everything will be done together and supervised by chaperones. I have found if our cabin has game tables and other recreation activities, then most of the time youth want to hang out there during free time.
3. **How will you travel?** We will travel in the church buses. Another reason we need parents to sign up to help!
4. **Why only 7th-12th grade?** I have found that a year in confirmation and the benefit of a year of MS helps the current 6th graders appreciate their experience when they do attend Resurrection.
5. **Will they need extra spending money?** Yes, they will need additional money for meals. Once the schedule is released, I will be able to give parents a better estimate.
6. **Will they be allowed to buy other items?** Depends. They can buy shirts, snacks or any other type of non distracting item. Loud noise makers, faux weapons such as air soft guns, weapons of any kind such as throwing stars or any type of potentially harmful or distracting item will not be allowed on this trip. Failure to follow this guideline will result in a dismissal from the trip and a parent picking up the students who violated this guideline.
7. **Can they bring a friend?** Yes, as long as the friend is a 7th grader - 12th grader, agrees to follow trip rules and parents fill out a release form.
8. **What are your expectations?** I expect both students and adults to enjoy the weekend together. Surrounded by many other youth groups in a worship environment, is a unique experience. I expect positive attitudes, a willingness to listen and engage, treating the cabin with respect, following the instructions of the adults and kindness to everyone we are surrounded by for the weekend.
9. **Jarrold, have you ever been to Resurrection?** Although it has been a number of years, I have attended Resurrection over a dozen times with groups of 50 or more. Not everyone will like the speaker or the band. But if they are willing to engage with their group, and have a good time, I believe they will walk away with something. Up until a couple of years ago they held Resurrection in Gatlinburg, so this will be my first time experiencing Resurrection at the conference center in Pigeon Forge. From what I have heard, this was a great move for the event that has yielded positive results.
10. **How many chaperones do you need?** We need at least 1 chaperone to 5 students. Please consider signing up. If we do not recruit enough chaperones then we will not be going this year.
11. **Why are 20 youth needed to go?** I want this to be a large group gathering for Broad Street. Therefore, we need at least 20 to go.
