Dear Acting Director Homan and Deputy Field Office Director Giles:

We, the undersigned members of Community Congregational United Church of Christ in Los Alamitos, urge you to release under supervision and to reconsider your denial of the stay of removal for Mr. Gurmukh Singh (A# 077-432-044), a loving father, husband, and son who is an active community member and who has no criminal record.

Mr. Singh's abrupt detention on May 8, 2017 at the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Santa Ana Field Office and his imminent deportation without time to prepare is causing severe hardships to Mr. Singh's family.


As a hard-working taxi driver residing in Garden Grove, California, Mr. Singh is the primary source of financial support for his household, which includes his U.S. Citizen wife; his two U.S. citizen children, aged 15 and 18; and his U.S. Citizen and Legal Permanent Resident parents, who are in their 70s and do not work. His 18-year-old daughter is graduating from high school on June 20, 2017, and has had to defer her college plans due to the uncertainty of her family's fate.

Mr. Singh is also the primary caretaker for his ailing family members. Mr. Singh's wife, Balwinder Kaur, battles diabetes, hypothyroidism, and chronic back pain, conditions that limit her ability to work. Mr. Singh is also the primary caretaker for his elderly parents, whose illnesses include severe Crohn's disease, hypothyroidism, diabetes, and chronic kidney disease.

It should be noted that Mr. Singh is in the process of applying for Legal Permanent Residency based on an approved petition by his U.S. Citizen wife. However, through no fault of Mr. Singh's, his case has not moved forward since the petition was approved in 2013. The inaction of U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services appears to be due to their misplacement of the file. Mr. Singh will be departing the United States in order to complete the processing of his Immigrant Visa case, but is dependent on USCIS to take the next step forward.

Our American values of family unity and fairness will be best served by allowing Mr. Singh to return home to his family while his Immigrant Visa case remains in process, and by executing the deportation order in his case in a reasonable manner. We strongly urge you to grant Mr. Singh release under ICE supervision and to reconsider your denial of the request for a temporary stay of his removal. To enforce the immigration laws humanely and reasonably in this case would not only benefit Mr. Singh, it would prevent extreme suffering and trauma to his family and community. Most of all, it will serve the best interests of Mr. Singh's 15- and 18-year-old daughters - and all other children in similar predicaments - who deserve to grow up with the love, care, and support of their primary caretakers, and faith in the fairness and integrity of the American legal system.


