



## **Juveniles Arrested for Burglary during Declared State of Emergency, "Hurricane Irma"**

**Palm Bay-** Special Operations Detectives and Youth Service Officers arrested three juveniles and one adult for a residential burglary. The burglary had taken place during the declared state of emergency on September 10th when the home owner/victim had evacuated from the state due to Hurricane Irma. Anthony Braswell 16

Charges, residential burglary, grand theft, possession of over 20 grams of cannabis, possession of drug paraphernalia, and disorderly conduct /breach of the peace.

Mario Ross 15

Charges, residential burglary, grand theft, possession of drug paraphernalia, and disorderly conduct /breach of the peace and violation of home detention.

Michaela Jordan 17

Charges, residential burglary, and grand theft.

Junior Selmont 19

Charges, residential burglary, and grand theft. He was also charged with violation of probation
