#### PLANT

What is a community garden and how could it benefit you? The standard definition is, "a piece of land gardened by a cooperative group of people living in the same area," but we believe it is so much more! These gardens are public resources that provide green space in urban areas; offer opportunities for social gatherings; contribute to community beautification, education, and recreation; and offer urban food security support. In addition to these communal benefits, studies have shown that community gardeners and their children eat healthier, more nutrient rich diets than non-gardening families.

#### GROW

There are always ways to contribute so join/volunteer with the Wickham Park Community garden program. From landscaping; picking; packing and weeding; to planting and harvesting; and assisting with the weekly distribution and market days, members can learn about the farming alongside UF/IFAS Extension Faculty and Master Gardeners

#### EAT

All harvested produce gathered from the sponsored plots will be used/donated to support anti-hunger campaigns within Brevard County. For example, donations to sharing centers and the UF/IFAS Extension Workshare program will provide eligible participants with the opportunity to work within our garden for a required amount of time; and in exchange, they receive a box of produce.

Open Enrollment for 2017 health plans starts November 1, 2016. Important dates to note:

- **November 1, 2016:** Open Enrollment starts — first day you can enroll, re-enroll, or change a 2017 insurance plan through the Health Insurance Marketplace. Coverage can start as soon as January 1, 2017.
- **December 15, 2016:** Last day to enroll in or change plans for coverage to start January 1, 2017.
- **January 1, 2017:** 2017 coverage starts for those who enroll or change plans by December 15.
- **January 31, 2017:** Last day to enroll in or change a 2017 health plan. After this date, you can enroll or change plans only if you qualify for a [Special Enrollment Period](#).

**Domestic Violence Support Group** – FREE , Every Monday (excluding holidays), 10:00am – 11:30am. A Free open support group for adult women who have experienced verbal, emotional or physical abuse by an interpersonal partner. Focus is on emotional reactions, resolution of feelings, the effects on everyday life, and on self-respect as a survivor.

**Childhood Sexual Abuse/Incest Survivors Group** – FREE open support group meets every Monday (excluding holidays), 5:30pm – 7:00 pm. For women 18-years and older who are survivors of childhood sexual abuse.

**Positive Psychology** – FREE, Every Wed. 10-11 am. and Wed. Evenings 5:30-6:30 pm.
