EVENT OVERVIEW:

Trunk or Treaters will spend the evening going from trunk to trunk, collecting candy from vehicle owners who have decorated their vehicles. "Trunkers" are encouraged to decorate their trunk, tailgate or hatchback and will provide candy for the "treaters". The Palm Bay Utilities Department along with the Parks & Recreation Department will be hosting a Free Movie in the Park at 7 PM.

RULES:

1. Registration is free for this event, however all registrations are due by 9p on Thursday, October 12
2. All participants must provide their OWN candy for distribution, the City of Palm Bay will NOT provide candy
3. Please be courteous to your trunk neighbors and keep your decorations confined to your parking space
4. No amplified music OTHER THAN Halloween themed music (no profanity or vulgar language)
5. NO electricity will be provided for Trunkers
6. Selling is prohibited at this event, however businesses may hand out promotional materials
7. ALL trunks and their owners will be photographed
8. Vehicles must arrive NO LATER than 5p and be decorated and ready to go by 5:15p
9. Vehicles will not be permitted to move or leave the trunk-or-treat area until after 6:45p
10. All vehicles will be assigned a spot at check-in
11. Vehicle owners must provide proof of insurance, vehicle registration and driver's license with registration form. Only properly registered vehicles will be allowed to participate in this event.
