Your student's achievement in high school is more important than ever! Whether your child is college bound or choosing a career path right out of high school, the teachers, counselors and staff at San Marin High School are committed to preparing your child for the next step in their life.

We are the "Academic Boosters" organization supporting all students. This past 2017/18 school year, we were able to fund many important needs for all grades:

- \$8,500 for Senior Class awards and year end events
- \$5,000 Valentings event for teachers providing supplies needed in the classroom
- \$3,000 teacher supply reimbursements at beginning of school year
- \$2,000 for Spanish language lab computers
- \$650 Screenager's parent and community event
- \$600 Principal's Fund for student achievement awards

We have immediate plans to spend \$2,500 for a campus beautification project, \$6,000 on technology and tool grants to teachers, \$5,000 to support math tutoring in school during school hours, and more counseling and support services for students and academic incentives.

SM PTSA Scholarship and North Marin Council Scholarship

Every year the San Marin PTSA awards two \$500 scholarships to two graduating seniors. This scholarship recognizes volunteer service both in the community and at San Marin. It does not have a grade point average restriction or requirement.

The North Marin Council will award a \$1,000 scholarship to one graduating senior. This scholarship recognizes extracurricular/volunteer time spent with children in the community. It does not have a grade point average restriction or requirement.
