Scott Croskey joined SkOUT Secure Intelligence in July 2016 as the Vice President of Policies and Standards. In addition to this role, Mr. Croskey develops and delivers cybersecurity reports to client C-Level executives on a wide array of industry trends, emerging cybersecurity risks, specific threats to client networks, and other relevant topics. Scott also assists in the evaluation of client cybersecurity programs as they are aligned to the National Institute of Standards & Technology (NIST) risk management frameworks (RMFs) and other internationally recognized RMFs. Finally, Scott oversees the training program for all personnel within the Oxford Security Operations Center (SOC) to include cyber security analysts, network engineers, and infrastructure engineers.

Scott is second to the SOC Manager in supervising and administering the 24/7 operations of the SOC. Scott is also a part-time Air Force reserve officer assigned to US Cyber Command at Fort Meade Maryland where he works every other month as a Defensive Cyberspace Operations (DCO) Mission Lead. In this capacity, Scott is responsible for 24/7 threat monitoring and incident response for over 2 million systems on the Department of Defense Information Networks. Prior to joining Oxford Solutions, Scott was an active duty Cyber Warfare officer in the United States Air Force where he served for 8 years. Additionally, Scott served as a Contracting Officer's Technical Representative (COTR) overseeing all technical aspects for Government contracts assigned to his area of responsibility.

Scott graduated with a Master of Science in Computer Information Systems & Security from Boston University and a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering from Ohio University.
