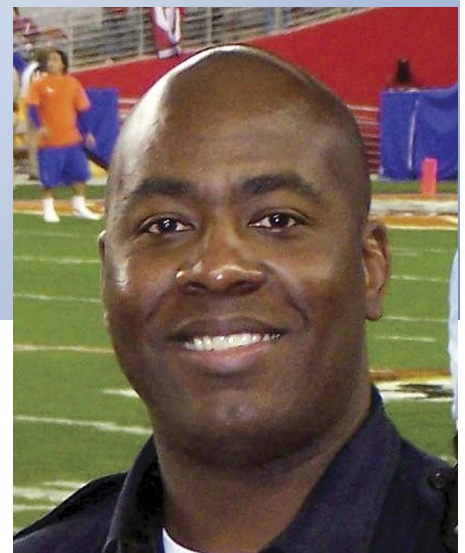


Mecosta Osceola Coalition to Reduce Underage Substance Abuse presents:

This workshop covers alcohol and drug clothing, alcoholic energy drinks, alco-pops, alcohol and drug concealment methods and containers, drug paraphernalia, drug related music, groups, logos, stickers, new technology, youth party tendencies, party games, non traditional alcoholic beverages, social networking sites, synthetic drugs, OTC drugs, inhalants, concentrates, E cigarettes, and popular party drugs. This session will also cover common stash compartments that can be used to hide weapons inside everyday clothing, containers and other items, along with the relationship between alcohol, drug and violent tendencies. Officer Galloway tailors this training to each community that he teaches in and constantly updates this to keep up with the current trends.

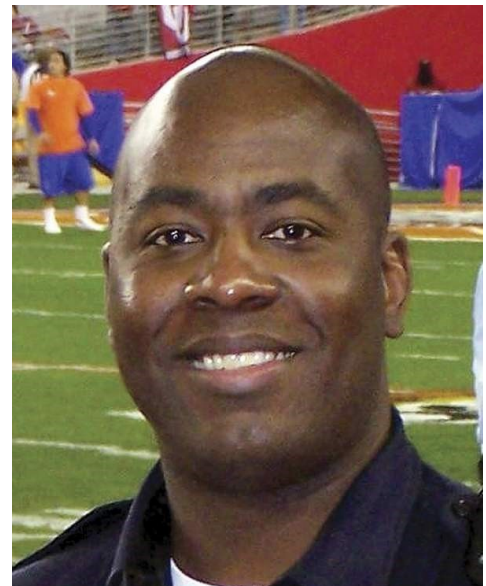
