Just 5% of patients survive – it has the worst survival rate of all 22 common cancers. Generally speaking, pancreatic cancer receives just a little over 1% of all cancer research funding. It affects men and women equally and for those that are diagnosed in time for surgery, their chances of surviving are increased tenfold.

This is the time when we have the most voices speaking out about pancreatic cancer. I ask each of you to learn more about ways you can participate, so you can help us raise awareness and funds during Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month.
