We have 22 electric sites, water is available but not a direct hook-up, and there are 2 dump stations to dump black water tanks. *The electric sites are assigned by your registration time on Constant Contact.* Be sure to register, even if you did the survey, so you can get on the list for electric sites.

Come with full water tank and empty gray and black tanks. Discharging of gray water is okay.

You must carry all your trash out. No trash service at the Ranch or County.

Arrive before dark to park or you will have to wait until the next day to park.

Remember to bring a flashlight.

AT&T is full service with 4G in the area, Verizon has no service. TV comes out of Waco.

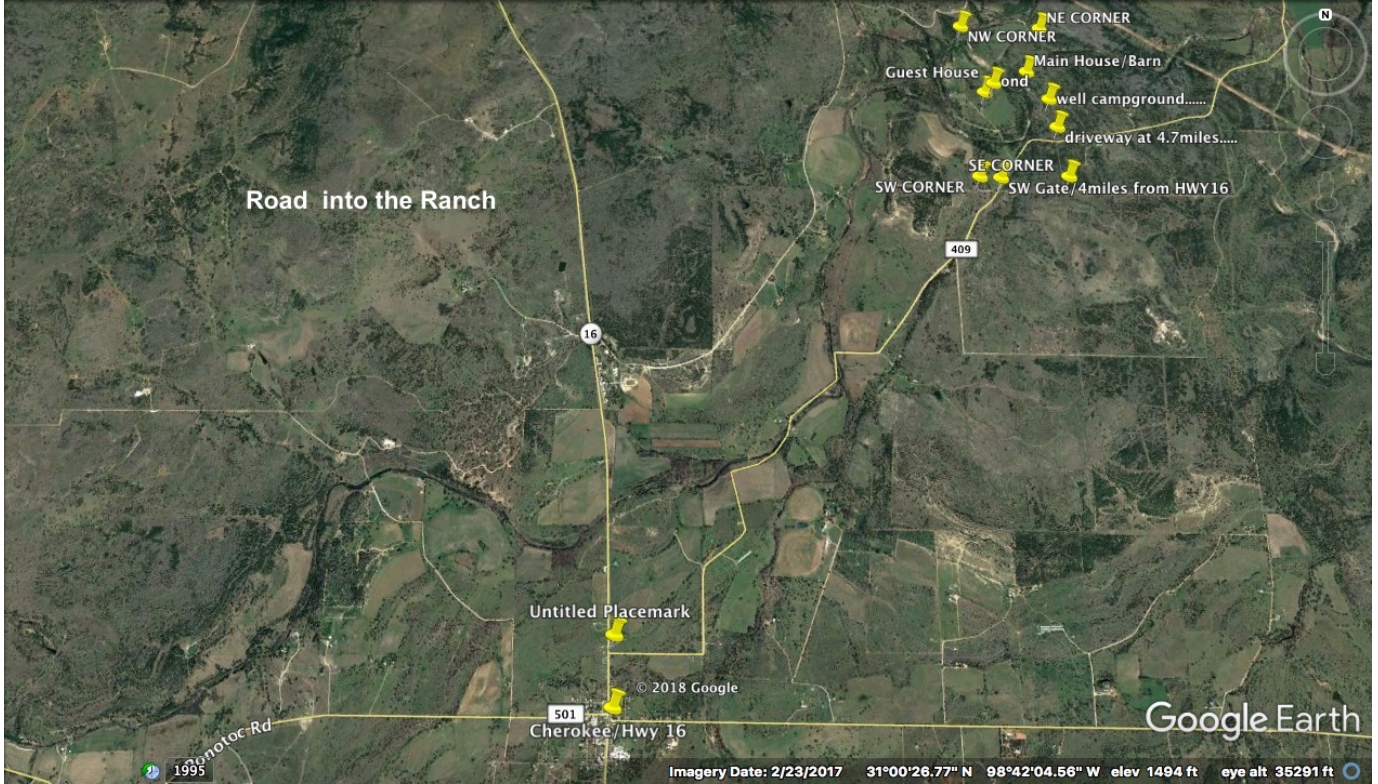
Those of you traveling to the Region 9 rally may stay Sunday night and enjoy the beauty and the sounds of the ranch.

Directions:

From Hwy. 16 turn onto County Road 409 and travel for 4.7 miles. Our first gate is 4.2 miles in and there is a 2 wagon wheel side gate by the cattle guard with a Farm Bureau/Fleming Ranch sign.

The first left after the gate you come to goes to the west side of the ranch, pond/guest house/boon-docking area. The boon-docking area is a 1.6 mile drive over to the house/barn on the driveway where we will have all happy hours and meals.

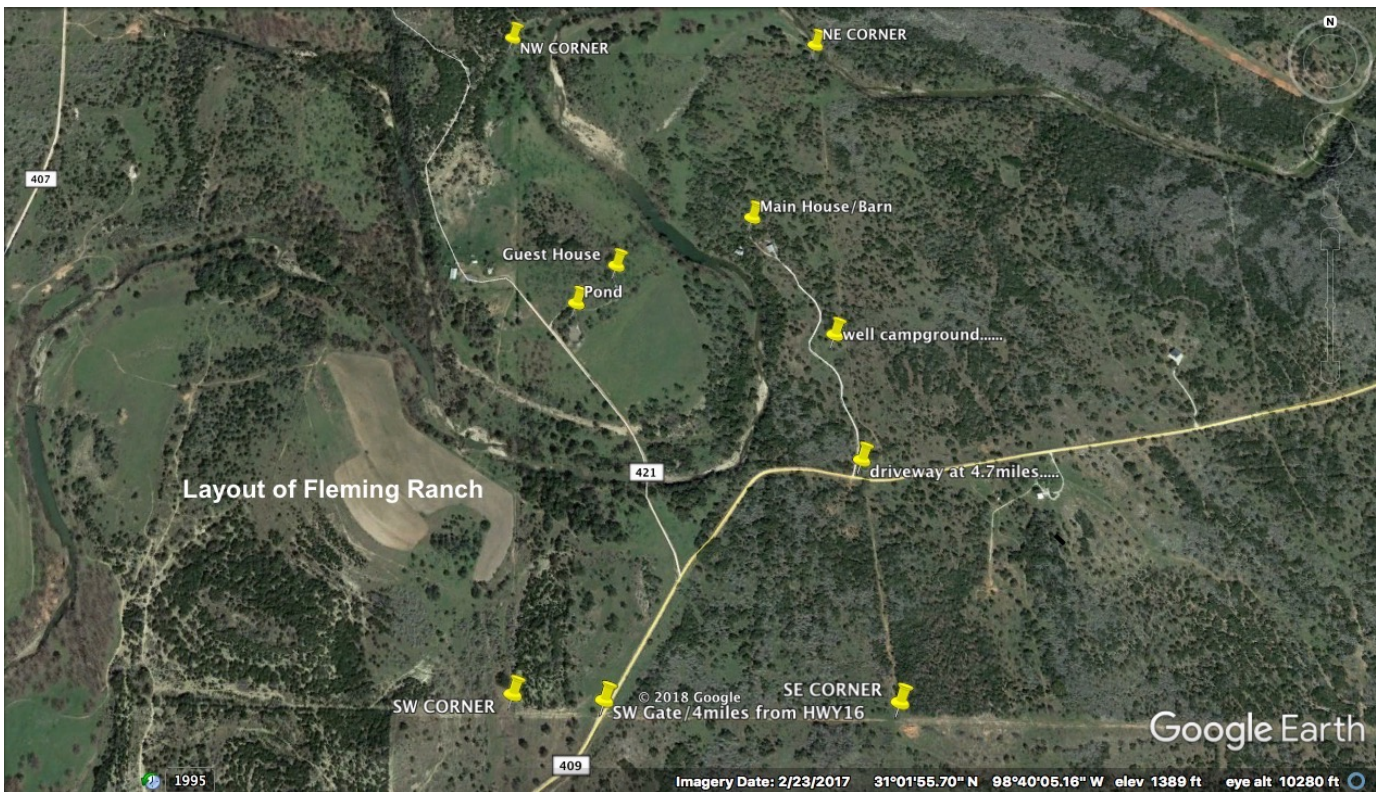
