Artwork not picked up will be charged a storage fee of \$10.00 per day.

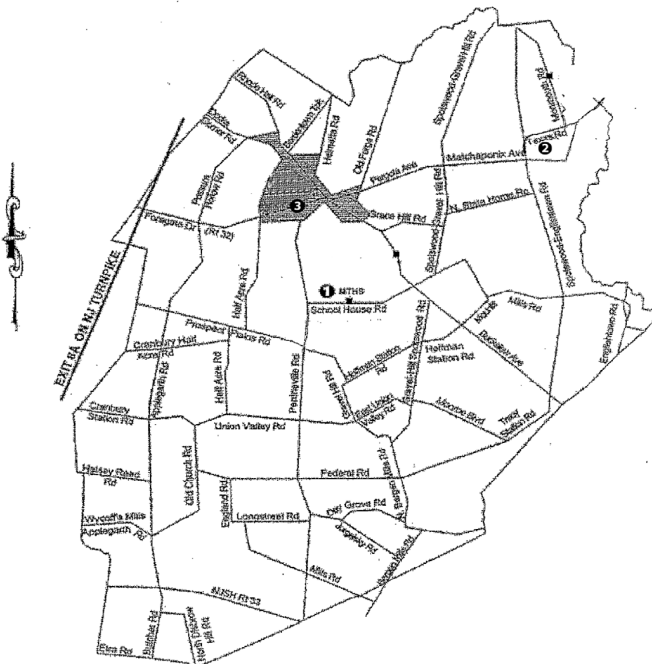
