Outreach met in January and reviewed the 2016 projects and programs. Most of the projects and programs we are going to continue in 2017 – actually the only ones we are not continuing are those that are situational in nature. For example support for the floods in Louisiana and for those in need due to Hurricane Matthew.

Another matter discussed was developing guidelines on the distribution of funds from the loose offering on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of each month. Vestry approved in November 2016 that the 2<sup>nd</sup> offering of each month would be allocated to Outreach. The Outreach Committee has established the following guidelines for money distribution. The monies can go to an individual in need, an organization or a specific project. We would like for organizations to have a 501 (c) tax code status. However, we are not averse at looking at an organization that does not have that status. Outreach will pay very close attention suggestion by parishioners. Actually, we hope to hear from parishioners with suggestions on who may need support be it an individual or group. Upon a suggestion, the Outreach Committee will review and then vote on that group for a specific month. A simple majority vote is all that is needed to then present to the vestry the group selected.

An outreach goal for 2017 is to provide a program each month for one of the Wednesday Agape dinners that will relate to our Outreach efforts. Hopefully this will provide a better understanding of our Outreach efforts and provide opportunities to develop new areas of interest. Another area discussed was developing a team of volunteers to assist in the recovery effort in the Gatlinburg.

Ok on to other things. Food on Foot distribution will be the fourth Saturday of the month and that is February 25. Mark it on your calendar. We will be filling bags on Wednesdays during Agape dinners and those dates are February 8 and 22. Thanks to Louise Dyer, FOF is \$250 richer, due to her association with Thrivent Financial.

Bingo continues on February 8 and as usual we need “all hands on deck.” One committee member suggested parishioners may want to bring in those holiday gifts that need re-gifting. So, if you have a gift that you keep wondering what to do with it – bingo might be the answer.

Our ministry with Food on Foot continues but we could always use more food donations. See the list below.


Every 2nd and 4th Wednesday evenings, we prepare lunch bags for many less fortunate community children to have on weekends.




