Directions

From the West on I-90

Canandaigua, Exit 44. 10 miles on Rte. 332 thru Canandaigua Business District (Main Street) to Rte 5&20. Turn right onto 5&20. Travel 1 mile on 5&20. Turn left onto Middle Cheshire Road. Go 4 miles. Turn left on Foster Road. Turn right at our sign.

From the East on I-90

Manchester Exit 43. Rte 21, go 12 miles to Rte 332 (Canandaigua's Main Street). Turn left onto Rte 332 and go thru business district to Rte 5&20. Follow directions above starting at "turn right at 5&20" . . .

From the South (Naples)

Rte 21 north 14 miles to Wells Curtise Rd (just as entering Cheshire). Right on Wells Curtise. 1/2 mile to Johnson Rd. Left 1/2 mile to Middle Cheshire Rd. Right on Foster Rd. Turn right at our sign.

"Lord, touch me . . ."

Lord, touch me... At different junctures on the Christian journey, we will discover and discern that we need the Lord to touch us in a particular and specific manner. When we are sick, we need the Lord's healing touch. When we experience loneliness or feelings of being unworthy, we need the Lord (to remind us) and touch us with His unconditional love. So Lord, touch me again.

Rev. Kenneth Gaddy, C.Ss.R. is a member of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. He was ordained to the priesthood in May of 1988. His first pastoral assignment was to the parish of St. Boniface, Philadelphia, PA. In 1990, he was reassigned to St. Patrick Church in St. Croix, US Virgin Islands where he served as associate pastor and then pastor until 2005. From 2006-2008 Fr. Gaddy was appointed as Director of the Blessed Peter Donders Formation Residence. Afterwards he became pastor of Holy Cross church until 2011. He currently serves as associate pastor at Sacred Heart of Jesus in Baltimore, MD.
