MEDIUM CATEGORIES

Painting, drawing, and graphic design/illustration.

PRIZES AND EXPOSURE

Latino Memphis will award a total of 25 winners – first and second place for each grade category – and an overall Latino Memphis Gold Mariposa Award. Artists may submit up to two original design pieces. Winners will be notified on April 23, 2018 via email. Over \$500 worth in prizes.

WHEN IS THE DESIGN COMPETITION?

Student artists may begin submitting their designs at latinomemphis.org on March 1, 2018. The deadline for final submissions is March 23, 2018. Winners will be announced on April 23, 2018.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

The competition is open to youth living in Arkansas, Mississippi and Tennessee, must be in grades 9-12th. They should have the artistic ability to express through their designs the fear of the unknown that many immigrant families face day to day. Not knowing if one day they will be separated by current immigration laws.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Judges will consider the following criteria: originality, artistic skill, and how well the design communicates the sense of urgency that families must take action and be prepared in case the unthinkable happens and families become separated causing great hardship and emotional distress.
