

The Outdoor Classroom at T.O. Fuller State Park provides a place where lessons from any curriculum can be conducted. It also provides contact with nature and the opportunity for rangers to give programs and teach your students about their ecosystem. **This allows for both the students and the teachers to simultaneously take a break from the standard indoor classroom monotony while maintaining the relatively quick-paced progress required for students to continue to advance through their academics.**

As an added incentive, if the Outdoor Classroom is rented out, the teacher and students can receive any of our programs **without any programming fee**. That includes the Interpretive Center Grand Tour, which is mentioned in the flyer, and our Bird of Prey program, which we are implementing a small charge for in the near future.

In addition to the Interpretive Center and Outdoor Classroom the park also has an extensive and interesting history, a new Natural Area, and the Chucalissa, a Native American museum and abandoned village. We also have 5 pavilions that can serve as a rendezvous for a teacher meet-and-greet or other events.





The T.O. Fuller Interpretive Center serves as an indoor and outdoor educational classroom in the Memphis/Shelby county area. Built to be as environmentally friendly and energy conserving as possible, the center is ideal for demonstrating energy efficiency techniques such as photo-voltic cells and geothermal heating and air conditioning. The center houses our flight cages, outdoor classroom, conference room, a gift shop and information about the native wildlife of West Tennessee.



Scheduled Tour Times and Fees

Guided tours of the Interpretive Center are offered Wednesday through Sunday. Tours include a program on the history of T.O. Fuller State Park, a bird program in the outdoor classroom, and a walking tour of a section of our Wildlife Enhancement Area. Tours begin at 2:00 PM and end at approximately 3:15 PM.
