They mobilize local human, financial, & material resources to expand capacity of low-income communities. VISTAs can effectively provide community needs assessments & resource generation through grants & other projects.

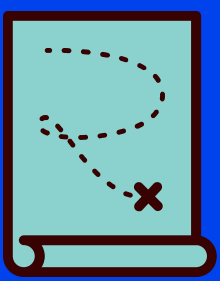


PARTNERSHIP BUILDING

Partnership building, fundraising, event planning, & research & data sharing are among some of the ways you can use your VISTA.

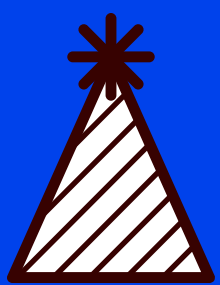
COST-SHARING PROJECTS

In order to host a VISTA for a 1-year service term, your organization will enter into a cost-share model where your organization contributes \$8K per VISTA per Year for a maximum of 3 Years.



This helps us cover the cost of a VISTA and allows us to provide you with the overhead support you need.

HOW DO YOU GET INVOLVED?



If you are interested in sponsoring a VISTA member with our project, it is important that you identify how your idea will build a sustainable program designed to lift individuals out of poverty.

Our project aims to connect full-time VISTA members with communities & organizations to address needs & disparities within Native American communities.

THINGS TO CONSIDER



In determining if this program is the right match for your organization's needs, think about the type of projects you would need your VISTA to accomplish. Except for training purposes, VISTAs should not be involved in any type of direct services such as manual labor, clerical work, or direct counseling.
