AIA Kansas City's Women in Design Committee is an association of women involved in architecture and the design professions who have come together to offer forums, community outreach, mentorship and historical research to our members and to the community.

This year, **Women in Design** would like to invite interested area high-school students to participate in the organization's 13th annual **Day of Shadowing** on **December 7, 2018**. This event is an opportunity to visit an architecture, engineering, interior design, graphic design or other host firm to see the design workplace environment firsthand. Group size will be limited based on the size of the host firm and each group will take part in a half day of shadowing from 9am-1pm with lunch provided. Participating students are asked to bring a list of questions for their firm to the Day of Shadowing. While **Women in Design** focuses on reaching out to women and girls, the Day of Shadowing event is open to any student interested in a career in architecture or other design professions.

Based on the information provided below **Women in Design** will match each student with the most appropriate host firm available. Once a match has been made, the student's listed point of contact (high school teacher or counselor) will be notified and responsible for relaying to each student their host firm's name, address and contact information. Transportation will be the responsibility of the school / student.
