Stewardship Kaleidoscope just got better! If you are a pastor, commissioned lay pastor (CLP) or leader of a 1001 New Worshiping Community within the Presbyterian Church USA, you can apply now, for a grant to cover half of the cost of your participation at Stewardship Kaleidoscope.

Thanks to a Lilly Grant, the Presbyterian Foundation is accepting applications for a newly established Church Financial Leadership Grant. Just like Stewardship Kaleidoscope, the intended purpose of these funds is to:

- Enable pastors to institute best practices for church financial leadership,
- Introduce new models of giving and stewardship
- Offer new ways to talk about money
- Form generous disciples within their church.

The Church Financial Leadership Grants are matching funds up to 50% of eligible expenses and applicants must provide the source(s) for the other half of expenses. Eligible expenses include registration fees, transportation, lodging, meals and other expenses for approved church financial leadership events, training and continuing education opportunities. The application deadline is June 30, 2017. Grants will be awarded July 31. Applications are available at presbyterianfoundation.org/financialleadership.
