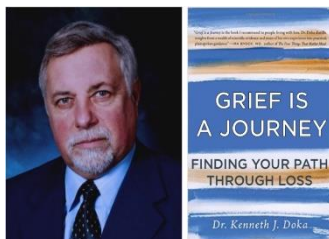

Concordia College's Division of Nursing proudly announces the program's first-time pass rate rank among the top five Baccalaureate Nursing Programs in New York State on the test for the licensing of nurses in the United States. The test is known as the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX).

Concordia's first-time pass rate of 95% is significantly higher than the average pass rate of 83% for baccalaureate graduates in New York State and the national average of 85%.
