

NYSDOH Releases Whiteboard Videos: DSRIP in 2017; Myths and Facts of Value Based Payment

The New York State Department of Health recently released **two** new installments in the NYS Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) Program whiteboard video series. In the first video, “DSRIP: Looking Ahead to 2017,” Jason Helgerson, NYS Medicaid Director, talks about what is ahead for the Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) Program in 2017, including the importance of the mid-point assessment. He also describes how Value Based Payment (VBP) will fit into and align with DSRIP and how it affects Medicaid in general in 2017.

In the second whiteboard video, “Myths and Facts of Value Based Payment,” Mr. Helgerson discusses common myths and facts about the Value Based Payment (VBP) initiative. He debunks common misunderstandings about the program and promotes the facts of what VBP actually means to those who are and will be participating in it.
