

hitesite.org: An Online Directory of Community Based Organizations

Through the website hitesite.org, the Health Information Tool for Empowerment (HITE) operates a user-friendly, online directory featuring approximately 5,000 health and social services available to low-income, uninsured, and underinsured individuals.

The website is sponsored and operated by the Greater New York Hospital Association, and lists programs and services available in the five boroughs of New York City and Long Island including **dental and optical; financial assistance; health care and medicine; immigrant support; mental health and substance abuse; social services; transportation; and wellness and prevention**. Verified information on services, eligibility, addresses, phone numbers, hours, languages spoken, other information needed to access services, and links to online screening for health insurance and benefits are also provided.
