Beginning September 17th, children in Grades 1 & 2 and 3 & 4 begin a new adventure called “Holy Moly,” a fun, playful and interactive approach to studying the Bible which follows the path of the biblical narrative, taking kids on a journey through the Old Testament in the Fall, Advent/Christmas/Epiphany stories in the Winter, and New Testament stories in the Spring, including Holy Week and Easter accounts.

One component of Holy Moly is an **animated video of the Bible stories**, which uses visuals and sound effects to give kids the opportunity to imagine and retell the story in their own words. After a few minutes of gathering and introduction in each classroom at 9:45 a.m., all classes will gather in Room 211 to experience this video together, then return to their classrooms to continue the conversations. As families gather at home on Sunday afternoons, we hope you will inquire with your children about what they experienced in Sunday school and keep the conversation going!
