

STATE OF THE CLUB - 2016

Each year, EWGA Corporate Headquarters requires all chapters to submit a yearly “Play Book”, which includes our budget and our Chapter goals.

In 2016, the Chapter goals included increasing our membership and participation levels by “having fun playing the game we love.” Even though our membership went down compared to prior year by 10 and we missed our goal of having 121 members by year end, participation in the golf events increased compared to 2015. Because participation was up, we feel we met the goal of providing events that our members enjoyed and valued. In 2016, the club held 24 long course events, 10 education events, a summer league and a match play league. In addition, we had players compete in the EWGA Finals, the EWGA Cup and the California Cup.

One of the values Members enjoyed in 2016 was the introduction of the Player’s Card which rewards player participation and volunteering. After attending 14 events, the player receives a \$50 credit toward the next event of their choice. This was so popular that the Player Card Program will continue in 2017.

At year end, we submit results to EWGA Corporate along with the year end financials and the Play Book for the coming year. The 2017 Playbook focuses again on Member Retention and new member recruitment. The club will again offer Summer and Virtual Leagues and Match Play along with popular formats such as the Partner Eclectic, 666 and Scrambles. The club will continue to offer skill and education clinics.

We met our budget goals in 2016. What you might not know is that our club receives a very

small portion of your annual membership dues – only \$35.00. The balance of your membership dues is retained by EWGA Corporate, to administer the headquarters function. For that reason, finding and retaining our sponsors is critical to the financial stability of our club.

In several previous years, the Sponsor Chairs were very successful in soliciting and retaining sponsors. Because we received sponsorship income over the amount budgeted and kept our overhead expenses on budget, the board felt that we had enough of a “cushion” in our bank account to price each event to break even. We charge the exact amount to our members that the course charges the club. Because there is a fee charged by Pay Pal, each event actually results in a small loss. We were able to also subsidize Championship finals registrations, pay for appetizers at the 19th hole, and award cash and gift card awards at events. The club also subsidizes several events during the year by charging considerably less than the course green fees - for example the annual Holiday Party in December. So, please take time to patronize our sponsors and to thank them at the events that they attend. Without them our club would not be nearly as successful.

We hope to continue to keep the green fees low, to subsidize events and to help with the costs of teams who make it to Championship Finals Events. If you have any suggestions for potential sponsors, please contact Gina Randolph.

Thanks again to all our members.... especially to those who not only attend most or all events but volunteer at events and serve on committees. Volunteers provide invaluable support – and earn extra stickers on your Player Card!!!

Have you wondered what our competitive events are about? Here's the skinny... by Susan Crawford

Three EWGA Competitive Events:

1. Chapter/Semi-Final/EWGA Championship

Stages:

- The [Chapter Championship](#), an 18-hole local qualifying round held at each Chapter location, **San Diego location Sycuan Golf Resort**, 3007 Dehesa Rd, El Cajon, CA 92019, **April 30, 2017**
- The [Semi-Final Championship](#), an 18-hole round will be held at **the El Conquistador Golf & Tennis Club/Omni National in Oro Valley, Arizona on June 17, 2017**
- The [EWGA Championship Finals](#), a two-day, 36 hole event held in **Hot Springs Arkansas on October 6-7, 2017**

The EWGA Championship offers two different competitive formats: Stroke Play and Team Scramble Competition. You select the competitive format that best fits your game, personality and skill level.

STROKE PLAY COMPETITION

Stroke play competitors play in one of five flights at the Chapter Championship qualifying event based upon their USGA Handicap Index.

Flight	Handicap Range
Championship	0.0 to 12.0
First	12.1 to 19.0
Second	19.1 to 25.0
Third	25.1 to 32.0
Fourth	32.1 to 40.4

TEAM SCRAMBLE

Chapter scramble teams consist of four (4) women who meet the eligibility requirements to play in the EWGA Championship. The team "handicap factor" is established based on the USGA Handicap Index of all four players.

Team Member USGA HC Index/ Computation Factor	
0.0 - 12.0	+2
12.1 - 19.0	+1
19.1 - 25.0	0
25.1 - 32.0	-1
32.1 & higher	-2

The Team Computation Factor

must fall in the range of +2 and -5 at time of Chapter Championship registration. Teams with a Team Handicap that is great than +2 will not be eligible to complete. Teams with a Team Handicap less than -5 may compete but the Team Handicap must remain at -5. Only one member of the team shall have a handicap index of 12.0 or less as of the handicap cut-off date for the Chapter Championship.

TO QUALIFY, EWGA MEMBERS MUST:

- Follow the registration guidelines distributed by your local Chapter• Be a female, EWGA member in good standing (*EWGA Gender Policy applies*)
- Have a verifiable USGA Handicap Index and have an equivalent of two 18-hole scores posted to your handicap record in the current year, **prior** to the handicap cut-off date for their respective Chapter Championship
- Be an amateur golfer as defined by USGA Rules of Amateur Status

The event will be played on the Celebrity and Players Courses. The format is match play, Day 1 either **partner fourball** (better ball) or foursomes (alternate shot), Day 2 **singles**.

3. EWGA Cup Qualifier/National Championship



The **EWGA Cup** is an amateur match play competition conducted under the direction of the EWGA Association Headquarters (EWGA). Competition is conducted in two stages of play:

- Cup Qualifier** – 18 holes of **Four-Ball*** and 18 holes of **Singles**** completed over 2 days to determine the teams that will advance to The Cup Finals. Qualifiers will be held on **September 23-24, 2017**, location **TBD**. Go to [EWGA cup](#) website and click on the Regional Qualifiers tab for details about each Regional Qualifier.

- National Championship - The Cup Finals** – 18 holes of **Four-Ball*** and 18 holes **Singles**** completed over 2 days to be held at **LPGA International Jones & Hills course, Daytona Beach, Florida on October 27-28, 2017**.

All players who wish to compete in the EWGA Cup must meet the [eligibility requirements](#).

COMPETITIVE LADDER UPDATE By Susan Crawford

The San Diego Chapter is using a competitive ladder to field our competitive events: the California Cup and the EWGA Cup. The competitive ladder is based on how you play against your course handicap at our 18 hole EWGA events. There is sign-up sheet to enter your score and your course handicap at the end of each round.

The “over/under par” numbers below indicate “net par”, your gross score compared to the course par plus your handicap (HC). If the % shown is negative, it means the player has played on average below her HC, if the % is positive, the player has played over her HC.

The key to winning competitive events is to **PLAY TO YOUR HANDICAP** and you will win most of the time!!! For the 2017 season, we are going to base the ladder on the last 15 events played (not just within the year) and you must play at least 4 of those events to qualify.

The top 15 on the current leaderboard are shown below. These players have played at least the minimum of 4 times. There are currently 41 players on the complete list. [Click Here](#) for the complete leaderboard.

Golf Programs and Education

LOCAL RULE: ACCIDENTAL MOVEMENT OF A BALL ON THE PUTTING GREEN

WHAT IT MEANS: The committee in charge of a competition or course now has the option to adopt a Local Rule that eliminates the penalty for **all** circumstances when a player, an opponent or either of their partners, caddies or equipment **accidentally** moves a ball or ball-marker on the putting green.

HOW IT WORKS | The following are examples where the Local Rule would apply:

IF: When preparing to make a stroke, a player accidentally causes the ball to move...



THEN: No penalty, and the ball must be replaced.

IF: A player accidentally drops his/her ball, which hits and moves the ball-marker...



THEN: No penalty, and the ball-marker must be replaced.

IF: A player accidentally drops his/her ball-marker, which hits and moves the ball...



THEN: No penalty, and the ball must be replaced.

IF: A player accidentally kicks and moves his/her ball...



THEN: No penalty, and the ball must be replaced.

HOW IT DOESN'T WORK | The following are examples where the Local Rule would not apply:

IF: A player intentionally moves or lifts his/her ball on the putting green without first marking its location...

THEN: One-stroke penalty, and the ball must be replaced.

IF: A player accidentally moves his/her ball that is lying on the fairway, in the rough or in a bunker...

THEN: One-stroke penalty, and the ball must be replaced.
