


The award acknowledges Ms. Roth's extraordinary efforts in revealing one of the greatest tragedies of our time; the criminalization of mental illness.

Insane: America's Criminal Treatment of Mental Illness is an urgent exposé of the mental health crisis in our courts, jails, and prisons. The book goes deep inside the criminal justice system to reveal how America's tough-on-crime policies have transformed it into a warehouse for people with mental illness, one where prisoners are denied proper treatment, abused, and punished in ways that make them sicker.

[Improving the criminal justice-mental illness interface](#) is one of NAM-NYS's primary advocacy priorities. We are tremendously grateful to Alisa for shedding light on the issues surrounding the fact that 60% of the corrections population has a diagnosable psychiatric disorder. This is a crisis both here in New York and nationally and we are honored to recognize Alisa's commitment to giving this epidemic the attention and scrutiny it deserves.


