### Journey with the Global Church in 2017

As part of *The Campaign for the ELCA*, one of the main Global Ministry projects is helping build a Lutheran center and clinic in Juba, South Sudan. Mawien Ariik, sharing his story and explaining why the ELCA has made this project a priority in the midst of conflict and violence in the nation. Pastor Ariik says, "Even in the midst of this problem [the violence in the country], God is there. It wasn't until a graduate school class that she was challenged to not assume that her thoughts are representative of everyone else's thoughts.
