BY THE NUMBERS: THE CAMPAIGN FOR THE ELCA


July through October are our most anxious months of the year. Typically, after monthly increases in giving to ELCA World Hunger that extend from April through June, the income figures lag. About 20 percent of our income is received in these four months. The trend was especially dramatic for 2016 where the July income was about half of what we received in June.

Fear not, this lag comes after having broken all-time income records for six of the last seven months. August is looking good.

We still have half the fiscal year to go, in which we hope to receive 63 percent of our income. Continue the

generosity!
