Continuum of Care Members,

On August 21, 2018, the PRAC (Performance Review and Allocations Committee), as nominated by the Continuum of Care Board of Directors, met to review \$21,290,656 in Continuum of Care Renewal and New applications. After their deliberations, \$18,099,929 was preliminarily awarded, including Bonus and Domestic Violence Bonus projects, pending HUD review and final determinations.

The PRAC made their final funding recommendations based on many factors including overall performance, quality of application, population type, project component type and the amount which renewals had recaptured by HUD at the close of their most recent grant year.

The PRAC also made the decision this year that renewals with recapture from the prior grant year would receive a reduction in award this cycle equal to a portion of that recapture amount.

This decision allowed for partial or full funding of all renewals within tier 1 and tier 2 as well as a few high-ranking new applications.

Additionally, the PRAC reviewed all new bonus and domestic violence bonus applications and made funding recommendations that will be sent to HUD for final funding decision in the national competition for those categories.
