



The City of Fort Lauderdale routinely monitors for drinking water contaminants according to federal and state laws, rules and regulations. As part of the Safe Drinking Water Act, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires the City of Fort Lauderdale, and all community water systems, to provide its customers with a Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), commonly referred to as the Water Quality Report, by July 1st each year. This report provides important information about regulated drinking water contaminants and their health effects, the City's water source, and the water treatment process.

Community water systems may provide their CCRs electronically. The City's Water Quality Report is now available online at www.fortlauderdale.gov/wqr. To receive a paper copy, complete the Water Quality Report registration form at www.fortlauderdale.gov/wqr or call 24-Hour Neighbor Call Center at (954) 828-8000.
