We are pleased to announce that we have relocated and improved the archery range at La Foret! Archery will now be located among the shade of the trees, situated safely between cabins. With the new arrangement, archery will be a more easily accessible and notable point on our map.

The range includes four new targets, additions to our collection of compound bows, and a new safety net as a backstop. We will have picnic tables in the shade to rest, have a snack, and enjoy the archery experience even more.

Archery is safe for kids and adults alike, and will certainly enhance your experience at La Foret! Archery sessions are also available outside of our kid's day camp program. Wishes for Windows

Throughout the year La Foret relies on financial support of individuals to maintain and improve our facilities. Periodically there are larger scale items that do not fit in our budget. In the recent past we ran a mattress campaign resulting in all of our cabins receiving brand new mattresses. La Foret would not have been able to purchase mattresses for every building without the help of our donors and those of you who love La Foret. We have a new large scale need that we will not be able to accomplish without the help of every one of you!

Our cabins are in dire need of new windows. Many of the current windows have been in the cabins since the day they were built and are single pane windows that are missing screens and do not seal well. Having a single window installed will cost anywhere from \$300-\$500. We have around 80 windows to replace. At the moment we have only raised \$5,000. We will start with replacing the windows in one cabin and hope that we have enough funds to move on to the next. 
