The Explorer's and Youth Transition Program through The Arc of Spokane is putting on activities throughout the summer. The events range from crafts to kickball to everything in between! We hope that everyone finds an activity that they are passionate about to participate in. These programs are for youth ages 13 to 17 years old that want to enjoy summer vacation and meet some new people. Our goal is to maintain a faculty ratio of about 2 to 3 campers for every staff depending on the activity. ### **PARTICIPATION INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES**

- 1.) Membership Eligibility & Registration Review: Registrations may be returned in person or by mail. Eligibility will be determined on submission of a completed registration, space available in desired activities and the general level of support required. A staff of The Arc of Spokane Explorers Program may contact you via phone to gather any additional information that may be needed. You will receive a confirmation via email of activities registered for once your application has been submitted, reviewed, and payment has been received.
- 2.) Payment of Fees: It is expected that payment be received at the time of registration. Checks should be made out to: **The Arc of Spokane**
- 3.) Participant Responsibility: Participants are expected to act in an appropriate manner. This includes, but is not limited to: showing respect and consideration for each participant and staff member, following staff instructions, managing anger, respecting others' personal property, etc.
- 4.) Personal Assistance: Our staff does not have the training or legal authority to administer medications or provide behavior management services. We are not generally able to provide one-on-one personal assistance or care, including toileting assistance, feeding people or transferring people in or out of wheelchairs. We are also generally unable to assist people with preparing lunches (including cutting fruits, vegetables, sandwiches, etc.), dressing and undressing (coats, hats, gloves, etc.) and any other personal care routines. We will offer verbal prompts and reminders when possible, however we cannot guarantee our ability to do this on a regular basis. Physical redirection will be used only to prevent immediate danger from occurring.
- 5.) Emergencies: In the event of an emergency, we will follow standard first-aid and CPR procedures, then contact the home as soon as possible. For non-911 emergencies, the parent or emergency contact will be expected to pick the person up within 30 minutes; therefore, it is imperative that we have a working emergency number in each member's file.
- 6.) Transportation: Rides to and from the assigned location must be arranged by the participant or provider and must coincide with activity times. Arrival and departure from the assigned location should be within 15 minutes of the noted times. **WE CANNOT GUARANTEE STAFF WILL ARRIVE AT THE LOCATION PRIOR TO 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE ACTIVITY TIME LISTED.**

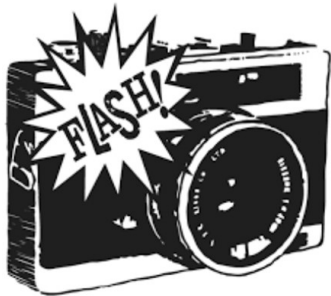

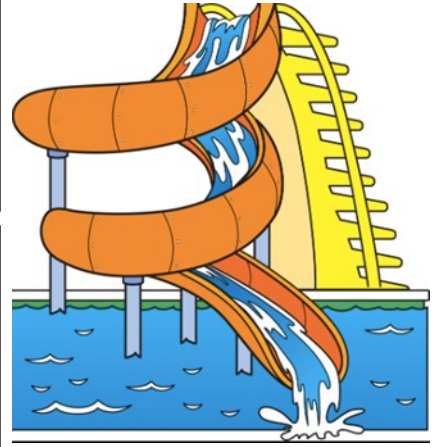
