How can CCH help you?

Current CCH resources and services primarily focus on research, and include:

- Partnership brokering and development for community-academic research teams including patient, clinician, and community stakeholder engagement
- Workshops, seminars, and online resources for team training, faculty development, community capacity-building
- Funding opportunities (including partnership development and research seed grants)
- Consultations and technical assistance for design and implementation of community-engaged/based projects including research proposal review and support (individual or group consultation (Stakeholder Academic Resource Panels (ShARPs))

Most CCH resources and services are offered through one or more of its programs:

- **Alliance for Research in Chicagoland Communities (ARCC):** fosters collaborative research between community- and faith-based organizations, public agencies, and Northwestern research teams.
- **Practice-Based Research Program (PBR):** fosters collaborative research between community-based practitioners and Northwestern research teams. Two practice-based research networks, REACH and PPRG.
 - REACH: 17 clinical sites affiliated with NU, including private practices and federally qualified health centers (FQHCs) with more than 160 member physicians
 - Pediatric Practice Research Group (PPRG): regional network founded in 1984 as partnership of Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago Department of Pediatrics and over 50 pediatric practices
