

Attention Students and Parents,

DeVry University has partnered with DeKalb County School District to offer high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to enroll in the DeVry University Advantage Academy dual enrollment program. If selected, students have the opportunity to earn an **Associate of Science degree in Network Systems Administration** while simultaneously enrolled in their junior and senior years of high school.

Eligibility

Students must meet the following requirements to be eligible for the Advantage Academy program:

- Participate as a student enrolled in a school district offering the program.
- Have successfully completed 10th grade and have not yet begun the junior or senior year of high school.
- Have a cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Have maintained a minimum attendance in high school of 90% prior to admission to the DeVry University Advantage Academy and possess a good discipline record.
- **Receive standard MATH 104 and ENGL 112 scores on DVU-administered placement tests.**
- Meet all course co-requisite and prerequisite requirements.
- Attend mandatory orientation with a parent or guardian and understand the commitment to a two-year program.
- Complete the Georgia Dual Enrollment Student Participant Agreement.

Application Process & Tuition

- Tuition and fees for certain courses are waived for DeVry University Advantage Academy students, and electronic textbooks (e-books) are provided.
- Students will not incur any costs if selected to enroll in the DeVry Advantage Academy Program.

Additional (Non-DeVry) Information Specific to DeKalb County School District & GA-Dual Enrollment

- The potential participant must be a student enrolled in a school district offering the program.
 - Specifically, to participate in the Druid Hills High School Cohort, students must be enrolled at **Druid Hills High School**.
 - Please contact DHHS administration for further details.
- Tuition and fees for approved GA-Dual Enrollment courses are offered to the students per agreement with the respective school district and state finance authority (GSFC).
