SAFE HOMES **NETWORK**



The Safe Homes Network of Fountain Hills is a group of almost 500 concerned parents and citizens who have taken a pledge not to allow those under the age of 21, to consume alcohol or illegal drugs in their homes.

HOW IT WORKS Download the app on your phone or tablet and when your child is invited to someone's house you don't know, check the Safe Homes Network app and if the parent is a Safe Homes Network member, give the parent a call. There is no cost to the program and you can take the pledge online at FHCoalition.org.

PRESCRIPTION DRUG DROP BOX



Community members can dispose of any unwanted, expired or unused medication in the prescription drug drop box at Town Hall Monday through Thursday 7am -6pm.

HOW IT WORKS Individuals can put pills in a bag or leave them in the bottle, bring them into town hall and deposit them in the green drop box by the MCSO office. The drop box cannot accept creams, liquids, inhalers or sharps.

TEXT-A-TIP



Text-A-Tip is a program that allows students and community members to report crimes anonymously. The entire community has embraced this anonymous tip line and many underage drinking parties have been averted or brought safely under control after MCSO received anonymous tips.

HOW IT WORKS Open text message feature and tap in CRIMES (274637). Begin the message with FH and then type in your tip. To keep the number handy, create a contact for Text-A-Tip on your phone or tablet.

EARLY ACTION KITS



Five FH locations distribute our Early Action Kit. This free parent resource contains a drug screen and early intervention steps for parents concerned about possible teen drug use.

HOW IT WORKS Go to one of our designated sites and ask for an Early Action Kit. There is no charge and you do not have to leave your name or supply any information about why you are requesting one. Go to FHCoalition.org and click on Early Action Kits to find a location.
