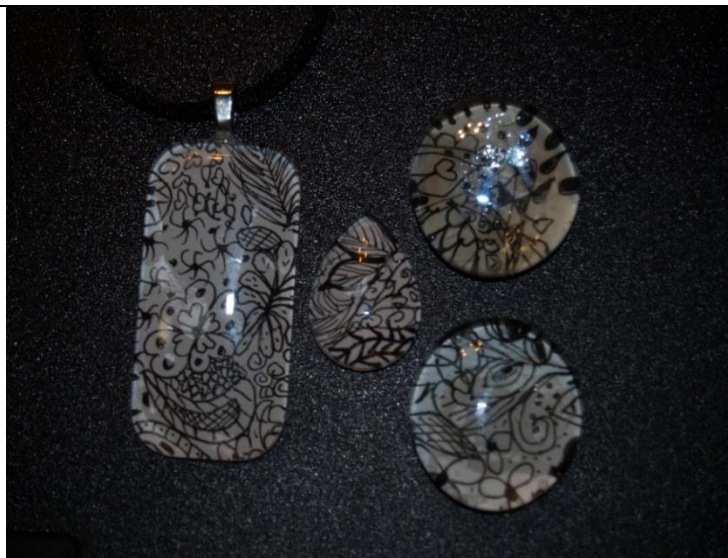
Friday 2:30 – 4:30

Saturday 9:00 – 11:00

Zentangle pendant, magnets and bookmarks. Bail and cord comes with pendant and magnets come with glass pieces. Bookmarks-design your own or I will have some made for you. You will make one pendant and as many magnets and bookmarks as you wish. \$6



Saturday 1:15 – 3:15

Handmade envelopes and greeting cards. Color may be added using watercolor, colored pencils, markers, chalk pastels, or you make leave them black and white. You should be able to make at least three. \$6

Double sided paper woven into snowflake ornaments. You should be able to make at least three. \$5
