#### **Responsibilities:**

- Maintain, repair, test and install electrical motors, ground power units, generators and three phase power.
- Install, examine, replace or repair airport lighting, airport signs, switch boxes, conduits, commercial lighting fixtures and other electrical components.
- Analyzes circuits, wiring diagrams and drawings to install, repair, calibrate, service or replace electronic devices and systems. Test electrical and electronic equipment and components for continuity, current, voltage and resistance.
- Performs work requiring a thorough knowledge of electrical theory and principles, statutory codes, properties of materials and principles of operation of electrical equipment. Knowledge of computer programs and wireless communication systems
- Troubleshoot, maintain and repair industrial, electrical and electronic control systems including large garage door motors and controls
- Conduct preventive maintenance programs and keep maintenance records.
- Willingness to be a team player and work well with others
- Ability to repair and maintain fire and security alarm systems.
- Ability to work in a man lift at a height of up to 50 feet.
