

CHARLES HEFLING STUDENT ESSAY COMPETITION

and the author will receive a prize of \$750.*

Essays on any topic of interest to readers of the *ATR* are eligible. Special consideration will be given to submitted essays that further the journal's commitments to creative engagement with Christian tradition and to interdisciplinary inquiry that includes literature and the arts, philosophy, and science. Papers written to fulfill course requirements, as well as essays arising from independent study, are welcome.

SUBMISSIONS

Submissions for the Hefling Prize should be sent as a word processing file in an e-mail attachment to

and should include:

- ◆ a cover letter giving the author's name and postal and e-mail addresses;
- ◆ a *précis* of the essay, in 150 words or less; and
- ◆ an essay of about 5,000 words in length, and not exceeding 7,500 words, including notes.

To ensure anonymity in judging, the author's name should appear *only* on the cover letter.

DEADLINE

The deadline for submitting an essay to this year's competition is JUNE 15, 2017.
