As currently reads:

ARTICLE XI: COMMITTEES

ARTICLE XI: COMMITTEES

SECTION 1: The President shall determine from time to time what committees are necessary for the proper implementation of the activities of the SOCIETY, and he shall then appoint the chairman and members thereof, as he may deem advisable.

SECTION 2: The Society shall have a STATE COLOR GUARD made up of any and all SOCIETY members who possess a Colonial period costume or military uniform. These members may volunteer to attend any event where the State Color Guard participates. The Society President shall appoint the Color Guard Commander and he shall conduct a Change of Command Ceremony at the Annual SOCIETY meeting.
