

TUITION INCLUDES:

One camp t-shirt per camper, crafts, Bible stories and related activities, snack and fun!

Campers should come ready to play hard and have fun! No flip flops, sandals or heelys please. If your child is still in diapers, or recently transitioned from, please pack an extra set of clothes in case of an accident.
