On Monday morning, please park and walk your child into the building to sign in at the registration desk and receive their name tag. If you have any medicine or epi pens that need to be dropped off, there will be a simple release form to fill out at registration. Tuesday to Friday, all children will receive their name tags on their mats from their group leaders and parents may drop off under the overhang after 8:45 AM.
