Day 1: Depart the USA

We begin our discovery trip today with our flight to Iceland. Sit back, relax and enjoy all the in-flight amenities. **(In-flight meals)**

Day 2: Arrival in Reykjavik

Arrive in Reykjavik today, where we will be met at the airport and enjoy a city Tour of Reykjavik before checking in to our hotel. During the Reykjavik City Tour, enjoy a detailed and comprehensive introduction to Reykjavik's past and present.


Reykjavik's renowned charm and bustling life is brought to light while viewing the city's main attractions by bus. Visit landmarks such as the Pearl, Hallgrímskirkja Church, Harpa Concert Hall and Höfði house, where Reagan and Gorbachev met in 1986 to begin the process of ending the Cold War. Gain invaluable insight into the Icelandic society and how Reykjavik has developed from a small fishing village into a modern capital.

Day 3: Blue Lagoon Experience

Start this morning with breakfast at the hotel before we head out for our Blue Lagoon Experience. The Blue Lagoon, Iceland's unique natural pool of mineral rich geothermal water, located in the middle of a lava field in the pure, beautiful Icelandic wilderness, is not to be missed and worth the hour drive to reach this unique site. A combination of mineral-rich fresh and sea water of 100-110 °F and surrounded by magnificent mountain ranges, the lagoon is ideal for wading and soaking in the 3-5 foot shallow waters (swimming not required), while the air temperature ranges from 25-55 °F. For those of you wishing to escape the beach, enjoy an **OPTIONAL Whale Watching excursion** this afternoon before returning to the hotel. Cruise the Faxaflói Bay in search of humpback and minke whales during this whale-watching tour from Reykjavik. A naturalist guide talks about the biology and behavior of these magnificent marine mammals while you look for signs of whales, white-beaked dolphins and harbor porpoises. **(B)**

Day 4: Golden Circle Tour

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing on our full day Golden Circle Tour. This tour showcases some of Iceland's most popular tourist attractions including the country's best known natural, cultural, and historic sites. From Reykjavik, the Golden Circle tour takes you right up to Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where the tectonic plates of Europe and North America meet and one of the world's oldest parliament was founded in 930 AD. Then, on to the Gullfoss waterfall, the queen of Iceland's waterfalls, tumbling down a deep gorge. Next stop is the Geysir Geothermal Area, home of the famous Geysir and Strokkur hot springs. The Strokkur hot spring erupts every 5 minutes or so, making it one of the most active geysers. From Geysir area, the tour proceeds to Skálholt Church, which was the seat of religious power in Iceland for centuries and where some of the most dramatic events in Iceland's history took place. On the way back to Reykjavik we make a stop at Hellisheiði Power Plant at the foot of Mt. Hengill volcano, where the earth's most brutal forces are harnessed and converted to clean energy for space heating. **(B)**

Day 5: Day at Leisure

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day at leisure to explore Reykjavik on own. This evening, enjoy an **OPTIONAL Northern Lights Excursion**. Hunting for the Northern Lights is one of Iceland's most popular winter activities, and this 4-hour tour from Reykjavik lets you do it in style, in a small group. Head into the dark countryside away from any urban light pollution, and visiting different viewpoints to see the radiant natural lights. (B)

Day 6: South Shore Adventure

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning before departing on our full day South Shore Adventure, where we will visit the amazing southern coast of Iceland, famous for its black sand coastline and stunning scenery. The first stop of the day is at the gorgeous Seljalandsfoss waterfall. Next, we continue on to visit the majestic and much-photographed Skógafoss waterfall. The thundering falls plummet nearly 200 feet over a cliff to the

valley floor. Then, visit the Skogar folk museum to get a taste of how Icelanders lived in centuries past. Today's tour continues on as far as Vik, a charming village at the southern tip of Iceland surrounded by beautiful high cliffs. Other highlights of today's tour include views of Mýrdalsjökull glacier and the impressive Reynisdrangar rock formations. (B)

Transfer to the Reykjavik Airport for our return flights to the U.S. (B, In-flight meals)
