Additional Requirements

All work must be performed by a Home Upgrade Participating Contractor. Additional details and restrictions apply. Learn more online, by asking your Participating Contractor, or by calling (877) 785-2237.

- A carbon monoxide detector must be present or installed on each floor.
- Testing must be performed after work is completed to ensure quality and occupant safety.
- The home must have a minimum of 10% energy savings or measure rebate value of \$2,000 or greater.
- Rebate and incentive amount can be a maximum of 50% of the total project cost, up to a \$3,000 cap.
- Projects that include central air conditioning or a heat pump, or their related fans, must submit proof of permit closure.

Energy Upgrade California® Home Upgrade provides assistance and incentives for home improvement projects that can reduce energy use and make homes more comfortable. This statewide program is managed locally by utilities and regional energy networks and directed by the California Public Utilities Commission in collaboration with the California Energy Commission. Funding comes from utility customers under the auspices of the California Public Utilities Commission. Incentives are offered on a first-come, first-served basis and are effective until funding is expended or the program is discontinued. Programs may be modified or terminated without prior notice. Calculate Your Home Upgrade Rebate

Choose any three (or more) measures to get started.

Whole Building Air Sealing

Reduce leaks by $\geq 15\%$, then \$250; if $\geq 30\%$, then \$450

Attic Insulation & Plane Sealing

Insulate to $\geq R-38$, then \$550; if $\geq R-44$, then \$650

Duct Sealing

Seal to $\leq 10\%$, then \$250; if $\leq 6\%$, then \$650
